#### MEDICATION

In compliance with regulations the crèche does not hold a supply of e.g. Calpol or other medications. If you feel your child may need such medication (e.g. for teething) you must supply us with same, and complete a daily Consent form giving full details for the administration of same (available in the crèche on arrival and to be completed with a staff member present).

In the event that you have not supplied us with the relevant medication we will require you to come to the crèche immediately if your child has a high temperature, if we are unable to contact you or you cannot get here in time, we will have to call the crèche doctor (Matt O'Flaherty) to administer relevant medication. The parents/guardians will be responsible for the call out cost of the doctor.
